**INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER**

1. TO VOTE YOU MUST COMPLETELY BLACKEN THE OVAL (●) TO THE LEFT OF YOUR CHOICE. An oval (●) blackened to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.
2. To cast a write-in vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, you must blacken the oval (●) to the left of the line provided, and write or print the name in the blank space provided for that purpose.
3. Use only black ink pen.
4. If you make a mistake DO NOT ERASE. Ask for a new ballot.

## Instructions on Returning your Mail In Ballot

- 1) Carefully mark your ballot. Complete both sides. Use the flip side of this sample ballot for our recommendations.
- 2) Put your marked ballot in the secrecy envelope and seal the envelope. If you don't use the secrecy envelope, your ballot will not count!
- 3) Put the sealed secrecy envelope (containing your ballot) inside the large return envelope.
- 4) Fill out the voter declaration on the outside of the large return envelope. Sign and date the voter declaration with today's date.
- 5) Return your ballot by mail by Oct. 21 or use a ballot drop box (find the nearest drop box using the QR code below). You may only return your own ballot. Voter Services must receive it by 8:00 PM on Election Day.

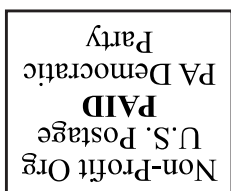
