DID YOU KNOW?

After the Supreme Court ruled on June 24, 2022 that **states** now determine our reproductive freedom:

- 99% of US House **Republicans** voted **against** a federal law protecting abortion rights.
- 97% of US House **Republicans** voted **against** protecting interstate travel for reproductive health care.
- 96% of US House **Republicans** voted **against** protecting access to **CONTRACEPTION*****



WHAT'S AT STAKE IF **REPUBLICANS** WIN

"A national abortion ban is possible if Republicans win control of the US Senate." - Mitch McConnell

- Women and men may lose the ability to control their own fertility.
- Women will die or suffer loss of fertility from botched, back-room abortions.
- PA Republicans have begun the process of banning abortion via a **constitutional amendment**. If they retain control of the state legislature in November, voters will see this as a ballot question in 2023, requiring only a 50% majority vote to pass (or fail).
- The Governor **cannot veto** a constitutional amendment.
- Independents & Non-Affiliated voters can vote on ballot questions in the May 2023 primary.
